Covid 19

We are aware there have been some confirmed cases of Covid 19 in another local school. However, I can confirm that we have not had any confirmed cases of Covid 19 at Oakwood. We are following strict guidelines in order to keep the school community safe and reduce spread and would ask parents/carers to continue to follow all the measures that have been put in place. Additionally, to ensure safety and to reduce risk of infection, could you please ask your children to stay off the play equipment. **When you are entering the school or are on the school grounds, please ensure you social distance by 2 metres.** Thank you for your support.

Colds

If your child has a cold but is not presenting a temperature, they should still be in school. If your child has a temperature of 37.8 degrees, your whole family need to self-isolate for 14 days in accordance with NHS guidelines.



- All children must come to school with a water bottle. Please ensure they only contain water and not juice or other drinks.

- All children need to have a PE kit in school.
- Please ensure all clothes, bags and PE kits are clearly labelled.
